

- use tools for creating e-content.


How will the project achieve this?

Project partners:

Coordinator Agency for Vocational Education and Training and Adult Education from Croatia in cooperation with five partner institutions from Slovenia, Spain, Lithuania and Turkey.

FROM A PROJECT TO A DIGITALLY COMPETENT TEACHER:



Project duration:
September 1st 2014 to August 31st 2016

The first phase of the project (until September 30th 2015) includes:

- content development for 5 online e-courses,
- establishment of a portal for e-learning,
- establishment of self-evaluation and validation of knowledge.

The second phase (from October 1st 2015):

- implementation of the pilot phase and
- training of teachers in order to achieve digital competence.

Professional teacher training will consist of five online e-courses. Teachers will build their digital competence by participating and obtaining certificates in all five e-courses.
